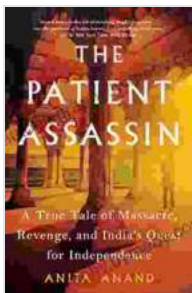

## The Jallianwala Bagh Massacre

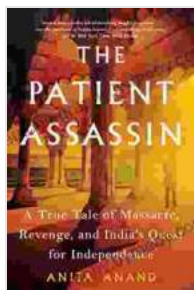

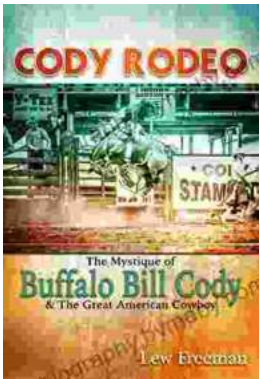
