

There are many strategies you can use to increase your chances of success on standardized tests. Some of the most effective strategies include:


- Start preparing early. The more time you have to prepare, the better prepared you will be.

- Eat a healthy breakfast on test day. Breakfast will give you the energy you need to perform your best.


- Arrive at the testing center on time. You don't want to be late for your test.


